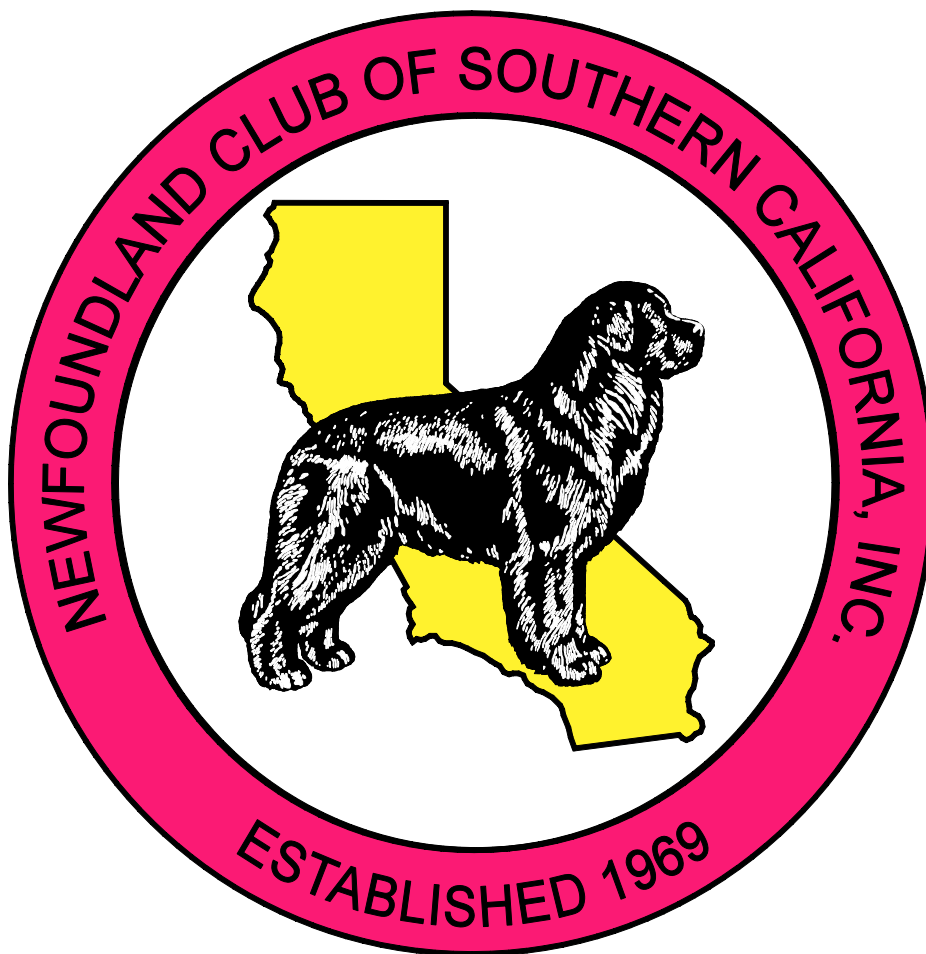

These Water Tests are approved by the Working Dog Committee of the Newfoundland Club of America (NCA) and sponsored by the Newfoundland Club of Southern California (NCSC).

Test Information

Entry Opening and Closing Dates: **Entries open for NCA members on July 28, 2019 and open for everyone on August 7, 2019.** Entries of NCA members received after August 7th will not be given priority over those of non-NCA members. Entries postmarked prior to July 28th for NCA members and August 7th for non-NCA member will not be accepted. Entries accepted by mail and must show a visible postmark. If you send entries via next day mail, please sign the “Waiver of Signature” space.

Closing date for entries is September 6, 2019 at 10:00 PM.

Entry Limits: Entries for each day are limited to a total of 25 entries regardless of division entered and regardless of how many entries are received for each division. The first 25 entries that arrive or are pulled in a lottery will get into the test regardless of their division. Entries over the limit will be places on an alternate list. Openings will be filled from the alternate lists in the order received. If entries exceed the entry limit; a lottery will be conducted for each day. There will be a minimum of 1 entry for each division in order to hold the test.

Re-qualifiers: Re-qualifiers will be accepted as space allows; untitled dogs will be given first priority even if their entry is received after that of a titled dog. Re-qualifiers in Junior Division MAY NOT post-enter Senior Division. However, new titlists in Junior Division MAY post-enter Senior Division. Dogs may be entered in more than one division on the same day, but only if they have already qualified at previous tests in all of the divisions entered. If the entry for the test exceeds its limit and a lottery is necessary, the dog may not get into each division entered. There will be no substitutions for dogs to change divisions if their entry is chosen for one division but not the other in a lottery. Judges must excuse any dog not in condition to finish the division entered and, if so, the dog will not be able to continue in any other division entered that day. Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs that are excused. Entrants are discouraged from pushing their dogs beyond their limits.

Entry Fee: First entry \$45 per entry, \$35 for additional entries and post-entries of the same dog on the same day. Please make checks payable to the Newfound Club of Southern California or NCSC.

Required Forms: Entries must be made on an official NCA entry form, and a copy of the entered dog's AKC, ILP/PAL, or foreign registration paper must be attached.

Water Test Regulations: These tests are conducted in accordance with the NCA Water Test Regulations effective March 2018. Exhibitors are responsible for reading and understanding the current regulations in their entirety. Test Regulations are available at a cost of \$5.00 per copy from the NCA Working Dog Committee Publications C/O Dwight Gorsuch, at 6282 Burriss Road; Rock Hall, MD 21661-1100. The document, as well as any updates made to the regulations, may be downloaded from the NCA website at www.ncanewfs.org.

Description of the Test Site: Castaic Lake is a freshwater, manmade lake. The shoreline is mostly sandy, though there may be patches of cement and rocks. Swimming depth is expected to be within 15-20 feet of shore, and may be more gradual in some areas and quicker in others. There is a large grassy area surrounding the lake with trees for shade, but exhibitors are encouraged to bring their own shade as temperatures can be very high. The test site is occasionally windy in the afternoon. Foxtails and burrs have been prevalent this season., please check your dogs carefully. Entrants are reminded that they enter at their own risk.

Schedule: Friday September 20th: Exhibitors may practice at the test site between 12:00 – 5:00pm. Saturday, September 21st: Check in time with test secretary is from 8:00 – 8:30am, with equipment check for WRDX division at 8:45am, and the test will begin with the WRDX division at 9:00am. Sunday September 22nd: Check in time with the test secretary is from 8:00 – 8:30am,

with equipment check for the WD division at 8:45am, and the test will begin with WD division at 9:00am. Equipment check for the WD and WRD divisions on Saturday and the WRD division on Sunday will immediately follow their respective pre-swims. *Entrants not present for the published check in time will not be judged that day.* Awards will be presented at the conclusion of judging each day. There will be a large raffle on Saturday.

Parking at Test Site: \$11.00 entry per vehicle.

Bitches in season: Bitches in season will be allowed to participate, but will be judged after all other entries have completed the entire test. Please notify the secretary in advance if you have a bitch in season. Bitches that have had an ovarian sparing spay are required to be tested as bitches in season.

Dinners: There will be no host dinners at local restaurants on Friday, September 20th and Saturday, September 21st. Please contact Test Chair, Celia Gebhart at (909) 238-5129 or pauzup@aol.com if you would like to attend. (All are welcome.)

Morning Hospitality: A continental breakfast and lunch will be provided for participants, stewards, and judges both test days.

Exhibitors Please Note!

The Newfoundland Club of Southern California will be using the new online registration program for this event. Online registration is OPTIONAL but your participation will help the NCA perfect this new program.

Entries for this test will be accepted through the NCA's online registration service at <https://www.ncanewfs.org/wdc/> as well as through the traditional paper method. Entries submitted electronically will be assigned a postmark with the same date the entry is entered. Entries submitted by mail will be assigned the postmark given as per usual. Entries submitted electronically and via post will be considered equally in date order for slots in the test.

NCA members will have the same early-entry window with both paper entry and electronic entry. If you are not a member of the NCA you will be prompted to provide the same contact information that you would provide on a paper entry once entries are open to non-NCA members.

You will be prompted to enter or verify your dog's information and you will have the opportunity to upload an image of your dog's registration certificate. Please have an electronic version of your dog's registration form ready for upload before you begin the online entry process.

NCA WORKING EVENT AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the NCA test regulations have been made available to me (us) and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem to be sufficient. I (we) agree that I(we) will uphold the AKC Code of Sportsmanship, the NCA Code of Ethics, and (if applicable) the NCA Judges Code of Ethics. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or test secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises or grounds and the employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the test premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim or loss of the dog by disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person or any other causes.
